
Call for Posters

CHES is the premier forum for presenting new results on all aspects of the design and analysis of cryptographic hardware and software implementations. The workshop builds a bridge between the cryptographic research community and the cryptographic engineering community, with participants from industry, academia, and government organizations. Since its first workshop held at the Worcester Polytechnic Institute in August 1999, the number of participants has grown to over 300 in recent years.



Posters should present work on a topic that goes along with the traditional topics of CHES as announced in the call for papers. Proposals for poster presentations can be submitted by sending a poster title, an abstract (up to 500 words), and an author list including affiliations to the session chair Amir Moradi at ches2013postersession@gmail.com. Note that there will be no formal review process for posters. Interesting submissions dealing with a topic relevant to the CHES community can expect a fair chance of acceptance.

The submission deadline is **Wednesday**, **July 31**, **23:59 PDT** (UTC-7). Please provide following information as a single-page pdf file:

- Poster Title
- Author list, indicating a contact author (with name, affiliation, phone and email address)
- Abstract (up to 500 words)

Posters must be standard A0 format. At least one author per poster should be available for discussion during the Poster Session.
